Our Tutor Training Course starts this October and is open to those who have completed Advanced Training with Pat Cane and who are regularly using Capacitar practices with groups or in their work.

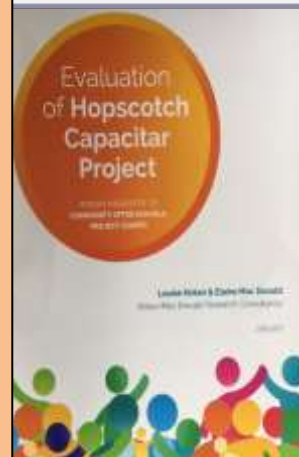
